Dear President Bush:

I was a victim of injustice at the hands of unethical federal court judges, regarding a civil case. Briefly, a federal court judge by the name of Lawrence E. Kahn, in the Albany, New York federal district court, issued a summary judgment against me in a patent infringement case. I appealed the case, pro-se, in the court of appeals in Washington, D.C. In a cover-up, the appeals court judges affirmed the district court's erroneous summary judgment. In doing so, all involved judges violated both Federal Circuit and U.S. Supreme Court precedential laws. To contest the injustice, I filed, pro-se, a Writ of Mandamus in both the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit and the U.S. Supreme Court. Even though the judges violated important precedential laws, the Supreme Court denied me a hearing. Must be that judges are above the law.

Since the Congress is responsible for confirming federal court judges, I wrote several letters to Sen. Arlen Specter and Sen. Patrick Leahy. Letters were also written to Chief Justice John Roberts. To date, I've been completely ignored. This conveys the notion that judges are above the law and can do as they please. It appears that the Congress and the U. S. Supreme Court embraces judicial corruption.

Based on cited injustice, I wrote a book entitled "America's Judicial Meltdown" to reveal to the public the obstruction of justice by federal court judges. Due to the controversial nature of my book, publishers feared publishing my book. I had to set up my own publishing company to publish the book. Once the book was published, I had a hard time finding a printing company to print the book, but I finally found one. When it came time to distribute the book, no distributor showed an interest. I've been forced to distribute the book myself through my website www.americasjudicialmeltdown.com. To promote the book, I contacted radio, television and newspapers for book publicity. To date, I've been ignored. Must be that publishers, distributors, radio, television, and newspapers are intimidated by the unethical United States judicial system, for fear that involvement would jeopardize the success of their business. Said intimidation of the media is being perpetuated by judicial terrorism. For the news media to ignore publishing the behavior of unethical federal court judges, is to suppress a citizens constitutional rights to free speech, such as to contribute toward a destruction of democracy.

As former President Harry S. Truman stated on August 8, 1950, "Once a government is committed to the principle of silencing the voice of opposition, it has only

one way to go, and that is down the path of increasing repressive measures, until it becomes a source of terror to all its citizens, and creates a country where everyone lives in fear.”

It appears that news media people fear exposing the unethical behavior of federal court judges. People who operate to suppress publishing the obstruction of justice by federal court judges, better pray that they themselves don't someday fall victim to the actions of unethical federal judges. A free news media is essential to the sustainability of democracy. A media that suppresses compelling analysis of important issues is not a media that citizens can trust to make informed decisions. Democracy can only be enhanced through a free and responsible media.

Based on the fore mentioned injustice rendered me, it is apparent that the United States is in great need of judicial reform. The following represents a summary of why judicial reform is long overdue in the United States:

1) President Clinton nominated Lawrence E. Kahn in 1996 for federal judge in the District Court for the Northern District of New York. Before Judge Kahn's confirmation, Ms. Elena R. Sassower, Coordinator at the Center for Judicial Accountability, Inc., requested permission to appear as a witness at Judge Kahn's confirmation hearing. Ms. Sassower attended Judge Kahn's confirmation hearing without witness status. After the hearing, Ms. Sassower rose and stated that there was citizen opposition to Judge Kahn's nomination, and that she made known such fact to the Senate Judiciary Committee months earlier, as well as the request to testify. Upon leaving the hearing room, Ms. Sassower was arrested on a trumped-up charge of disorderly conduct.

Ms. Sassower revealed the incident in her June 28, 1996 letter to Senator Orrin G. Hatch. The closure of her letter stated that “The people of the state of New York have suffered irreparable injury from Judge Kahn's politically motivated misconduct on the state court bench. They along with citizens throughout the nation, are entitled to be protected from the danger inherent in his elevation to the federal bench - - as well as from the dangers of the Senate Judiciary Committee, which refuses to do its duty and investigate documentary evidence of Judge Kahn's unfitness. It should be noted that the above cited Judge Kahn is the same judge who obstructed justice when he unethically rendered an erroneous summary judgment against me, which allowed companies to outright steal my patented invention. Judge Kahn is also the same judge for which Ms. Sassower was arrested when she tried to inform the Senate Judiciary Committee that Judge Kahn was not fit to become a federal judge.

2) Judge Kahn violated my constitutional rights to a jury trial when he unethically rendered summary judgment against me in order to favor the party of his choosing. In doing so, Judge Kahn violated both Federal Circuit and United States Supreme Court precedential laws.

- 3) My constitutional rights to free speech were violated because of judicial terrorism, when the news media was intimidated such as not to publish evidence regarding the obstruction of justice by federal court judges.
- 4) Federal Appeals Court Judges William C. Bryson, Pauline Newman, S. Jay Plager, Alan D. Lourie, and Timothy Dyk, covered up the wrong doings of Judge Lawrence E. Kahn when they conspired in affirming Judge Kahn's erroneous summary judgment. Said Appeals Court judges went as far as fraudulently citing an inapplicable case law in order to deny my petition for Writ of Mandamus.
- 5) My complaint of judicial misconduct of identified court judges was ignored by U.S. Supreme Court Chief Justice Roberts, and Judiciary Committee Senator Arlen Specter and Senator Patrick Leahy. Must be that judicial misconduct by federal court judges is permissible.
- 6) It should be further noted that I sacrificed 4 years of my life in the defense of this country during World war II, and in return for my patriotic duty, federal court judges railroaded me out of my patented invention. This begs the question: How would the cited judges feel if they were confronted with the above cited injustice?

If the above disclosed summary is supposed to constitute democracy in action, the United States better think seriously about cleaning up its own wrong doings, before it goes around preaching democracy elsewhere in the world.

Based on presented facts, it is respectfully requested that you take the initiative to pursue judicial reform in the United States, so that people can feel free and not be intimidated by judicial terrorism.
